Dear Parents/Guardians,

Welcome to the intermediate Beaver Brae volleyball season! This permission form includes the dates and times of all 3 of our tournaments. The tournament dates are confirmed but the time are estimated. More information for each tournament, along with the game schedules, will be synervoiced home closer to the tournament date.

Tuesday November 13th @BBSS and TA (Estimated 8am-4:30pm). Students will either be at BBSS all day or TA/PJP all day. Once teams are registered and the schedule is made, we will send a synervoice home with more information. Athletes will need shorts, runners and a water bottle. Cafeterias will be open at all locations. Jerseys will be provided by the coaches.

Wednesdays, November 28th @Dryden High School (Estimated 6:30am-5pm)– Students will need shorts, runners and a water bottle. There is a Subway in the school that students can purchase lunch from. They are encouraged to bring healthy snacks and lots of liquids. If time permits, we will stop at Safeway before leaving Dryden. Our estimated arrival back to Beaver Brae is 5pm.

Friday December 7th to Saturday December 8th @THE BEACH – Beach Volleyball Center (2600 Wenzel Street, Winnipeg)
This is a great opportunity for students to play 6 vs 6 Beach Volleyball in the winter, in a brand new state-of-the-art facility. All boys and girls will travel together and leave BBSS at approximately noon on Friday. It will be an overnight trip, and athletes will return back to Beaver Brae at approximately 7pm on Saturday. The boys will play on Friday and the girls will play on Saturday. Athletes will have an opportunity to go shopping at the mall, and possibly see a movie on the Friday night if there is time. We will be staying at the Humphrey Inn & Suites (260 Main St, Winnipeg, MB R3C 1A9). Students will need to bring spending money for 3 meals (breakfast is included at the hotel) and any shopping at the mall they plan to do. If we go to a movie, that will also be extra. More information will be proved closer to the tournament.

Please note that the \$150 fee covers tournament registration, transportation, hotel, and jersey (borrowed) for all tournaments.
