

Beaver Brae School Permission Form

Your student has been provided the opportunity to play baseball on the intermediate Broncos' Co-ed baseball team. The season consists of practices 1x/week at the J&M Baseball Field (Rabbit Lake) for the month of September followed by 1 tournament in Dryden on Wednesday September 27th. Students are encouraged to bring a water bottle to every practice, along with appropriate attire (i.e., shorts/sweat pants and a t-shirt/long sleeve). Cleats or runners will work great.

The practice schedule for the Sportsplex is as follows:

Wednesday September 6th
Wednesdays September 13th
Wednesday September 20th

All practices at the J&M Fields run from 3:30-5. Students will be bussed to the fields from Beaver Brae. Students must make their own arrangements to be picked up from the fields at 5pm.

Once the tournament schedule has been made, a note will be sent home that includes departure and arrival times for the tournament on Wednesday September 27th.

The cost for the entire baseball season, including bussing to practices, and travel costs for the tournament in Dryden is \$25. Please make payment online at: <https://kpdsb.schoolcashonline.com/>

General Sports Fee: This is a mandatory fee that is only paid once per year for every Intermediate Bronco athlete. The fee covers the athlete's ticket into the intermediate athletic banquet at the end of the school year.

Uniform: Students are required to have a purple Bronco shirt for the baseball tournament. Shirts can be bought through the tuck shop at lunch every Wednesday.

Baseball gloves can be provided by Beaver Brae.
