KPDSB strives to promote responsible global digital citizenship when students participate responsibly in online learning spaces and use both Board-owned and non Board-owned devices.

Violation of these terms may result in discipline such as loss of access, suspension, or expulsion as deemed by the school's code of conduct and the Ontario Safe Schools Act. 1	I agree to be a safe user whenever and wherever I access the school's online network and use technology. I will protect my passwords and personal information (including full names, telephone numbers, addresses, images, or video). I will inform my teacher if I think my account has been compromised.		
2	If I allow someone else to use my device, I am responsible for the device at that time.		
3	I agree to be responsible whenever and wherever I use technology and support others by being respectful in how I talk to and work with them and never write or participate in online bullying. This means not engaging in or supporting harmful, inappropriate, or hurtful online behaviour.		
4	I agree to report to an adult if I feel unsafe or uncomfortable online or see a friend being unsafe or being made to feel uncomfortable by others.		
5	I agree to keep myself and others safe by not sharing personal information, through messaging, social media, or otherwise.		
6	I agree to use technology and participate in online learning environments for the purpose of learning, and will use and care for the equipment properly, and not interfere with the work of other students.		
7	I agree not to search, access, download, or install unauthorized programs, or inappropriate, rude, or offensive content. I will advise my teacher if I have inadvertently accessed questionable content.		
8	I will let my teacher or librarian know if my machine becomes damaged.
