MANDATORY CRITERIA:

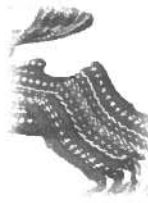
- **MUST BE OF METIS ANCESTRY**

**** EXTREMELY IMPORTANT**** Your grammar, presentation, and originality will be part of the evaluation. We use a point system and this weighs heavily towards our decision on who is the successful bursary candidate. Please use as much detail as possible as we are judging using the following in your submission – **METIS INVOLVEMENT, VOLUNTEERISM, QUALITY OF APPLICATION, SCHOOL ACTIVITIES, WORK EXPERIENCE & ACADEMICS**

ESSAY QUESTIONS:

1. Give us a background of your Métis history and describe what Métis activities and Métis traditions you and your family practice today. Include as many of the items as follows: Genealogy charts, pictures, photocopies of family artifacts, etc. to give us a clear picture of your Métis family.
2. If you were the Youth Representative on the Kenora Métis Council, how would you engage youth in your Métis community? Be detailed in your ideas.
3. Why do you feel you should be the successful recipient of this Bursary award?
4. Have you worked during the school years and/or throughout summers? If yes, please describe.
5. Please list in detail all school activities, extracurricular and community/volunteer involvement during your high school years?
6. Is Infinite Reach a Métis student support program at some Ontario Post Secondary Institutions? Yes or No. Does your preferred institution have an Infinite Reach Program? Yes or No.
