2018 APPLICATION FORM

By assisting young people in their pursuit of a college or university education in agriculture or food, we are investing in their future careers and in the future of agriculture and food production in Canada.

The Monsanto Fund Opportunity Scholarship Program is available to Canadian high school students who are enrolled in their final year of high school as of May 29, 2018 and eligible to graduate from high school in 2018. Those eligible for a scholarship must be planning to enrol at a Canadian post-secondary institution (degree or diploma) in a first-year agriculture, food science or culinary program.

If you have applied for entry into a college or university, but have not yet been accepted, you can still apply for a Monsanto Fund Opportunity Scholarship. However, if you are awarded a

scholarship, you must provide an acceptance letter from your educational institution.

Successful applicants will each be awarded a scholarship valued at \$1,500, based on demonstrated academic standards and leadership in the community. Selection will be made by an independent panel.

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III. APPLICATION ESSAY

Please provide an application essay of between 300 and 500 words (do not exceed word count).

Essay Question: **Canadian farmers play an important role in feeding the world in a sustainable way; what role will you play?**

 - double spaced
 - 1.25" left and right margins

A) REFERENCE LETTER

You will need to provide one reference letter from someone who knows you well, excluding family members. This reference letter should highlight the skills and abilities that make you best qualified for this scholarship. This letter is required in order to be eligible for the scholarship.

B) FARMER OR FOOD PROFESSIONAL NOMINATION

A farmer or food professional in your community will need to provide a nomination testimonial. In 250 words or less, explain why the student deserves this scholarship.
