Welcome to the intermediate Beaver Brae volleyball season! This permission form includes the dates and times of 2 our tournaments. The tournament schedules will be provided to students 1 week prior to the tournaments. Please be aware that we are hoping to register our teams in a 3rd tournament, but haven't been able to confirm it yet.

Thursday, October 26th @BBSS and TA – Students are to arrive to the tournament site by 7:45am. They will need shorts, runners and a water bottle. Jerseys will be provided by the coaches. The tournament will be finished by 3pm.

Tuesday, November 14th @Dryden High School – The bus is scheduled to leave Beaver Brae at 6am. Students will need shorts, runners and a water bottle. There is a Subway in the school that students can purchase lunch from. They are encouraged to bring healthy snacks and lots of liquids. If time permits, we will stop at Safeway before leaving Dryden. Our estimated arrival back to Beaver Brae is 5pm.

Please note that the \$50 fee covers tournament registration, transportation, and equipment (in volleyball, we use a small portion of fees over several years to replace jerseys, volleyballs and nets.) There will be an additional costs if a 3rd tournament in Winnipeg gets confirmed.

****The General Sports fee of \$20 is paid 1x/school year per athlete. This fee covers costs associated with the Athletic Banquet at the end of the year, and grants them their ticket in****
