There will be a Spirit Council meeting today at lunch in room 316 at 11:30.

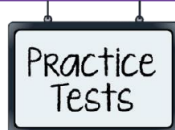
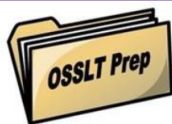

Coffee house performers, if your teachers give you permission to leave class, please come to the music room at 11 to help set up.

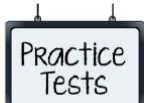
