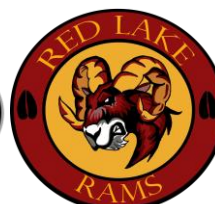
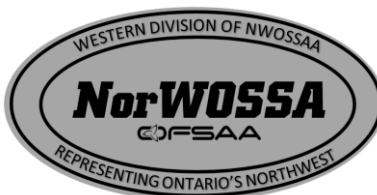
Attention all Senior Boys Basketball players. There will be a brief meeting at the start of lunch today in the library. Please attend if you'd like to be on the team this year.
