Grade 9-12 students are reminded that help with Mrs. Edwards is available today in the library during lunch for any students working on credit recovery or anyone needing support with current courses.

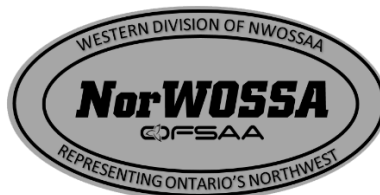
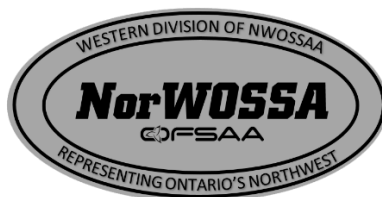
REACH for the TOP is a fun way to spend your lunch hour on Tuesdays— Come on up to room 305 and join in the trivia game fun.

Take your turn at the buzzer, racing to see which team can answer the most trivia questions. All are welcome.

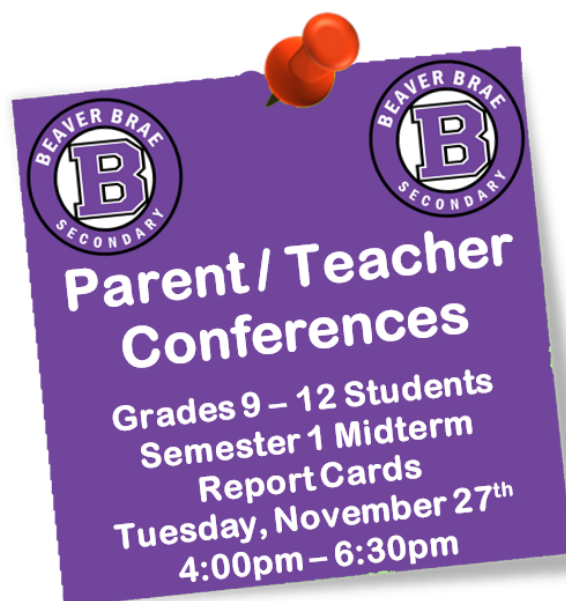
Grade 7&8 boys and girls volleyball practice will be in the small gym after school today.

There is also a rumor of popcorn being sold!.....and maybe there will even be some Christmas carols!

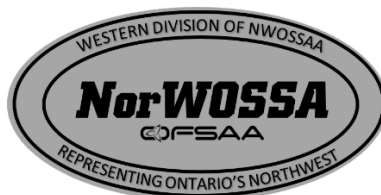
Attention all senior boys basketball players, your practice has been changed to 330 in the big gym today. Also, please sign up for the REMIND app today for further communication.
