Grad photos are on today, Wednesday and Thursday this week in room 255 in the Tech Wing.

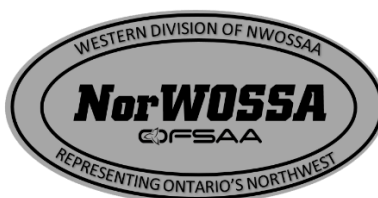
All grade 8 boys that want to play on the basketball team this year are to go to the small gym at the beginning of lunch for the first practice.

Grad photos are on today and tomorrow in room 255 in the Tech Wing.

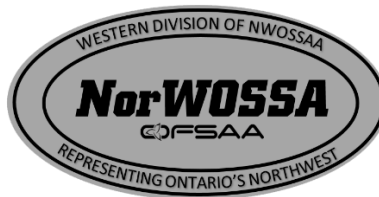
Reminder of the Grade 7/8 dance tomorrow night from 6:30-9pm.
