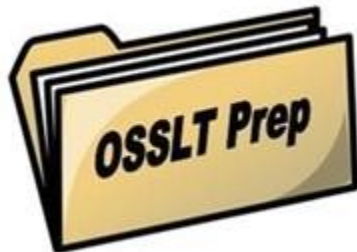

Grade 7 boys basketball practice is cancelled from 3:30-4:45 today.

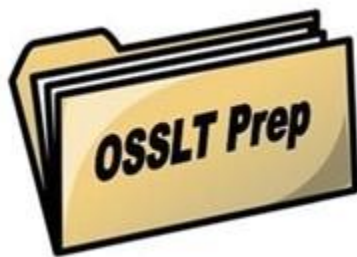

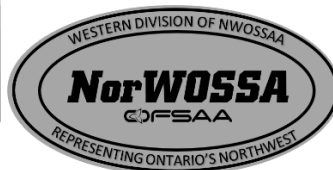
