145 years ago, on October 3rd, 1873, the Saulteaux band of the Ojibwa peoples and the Government of Canada signed Treaty 3, also known as the North-West Angle Treaty. The Treaty Adhesion was later signed by the Metis Nation in 1875.

The phrase "we are all treaty people" means that everyone in Canada — settlers and Indigenous peoples alike — are in some way affected by treaties. Listed as one of the 94 calls to action by the Truth and Reconciliation Commission (TRC) is a call to "faithfully observe the laws of Canada, including treaties with Indigenous peoples."

The impact of treaty making in Canada has been wide-ranging and long standing. The treaties the Crown has signed with Indigenous peoples since the 18th century have permitted the evolution of Canada as we know it.

We recognize today is Treaty Day in Treaty 3 territory and that we are all treaty people.

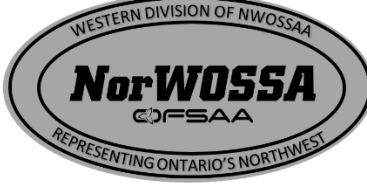
