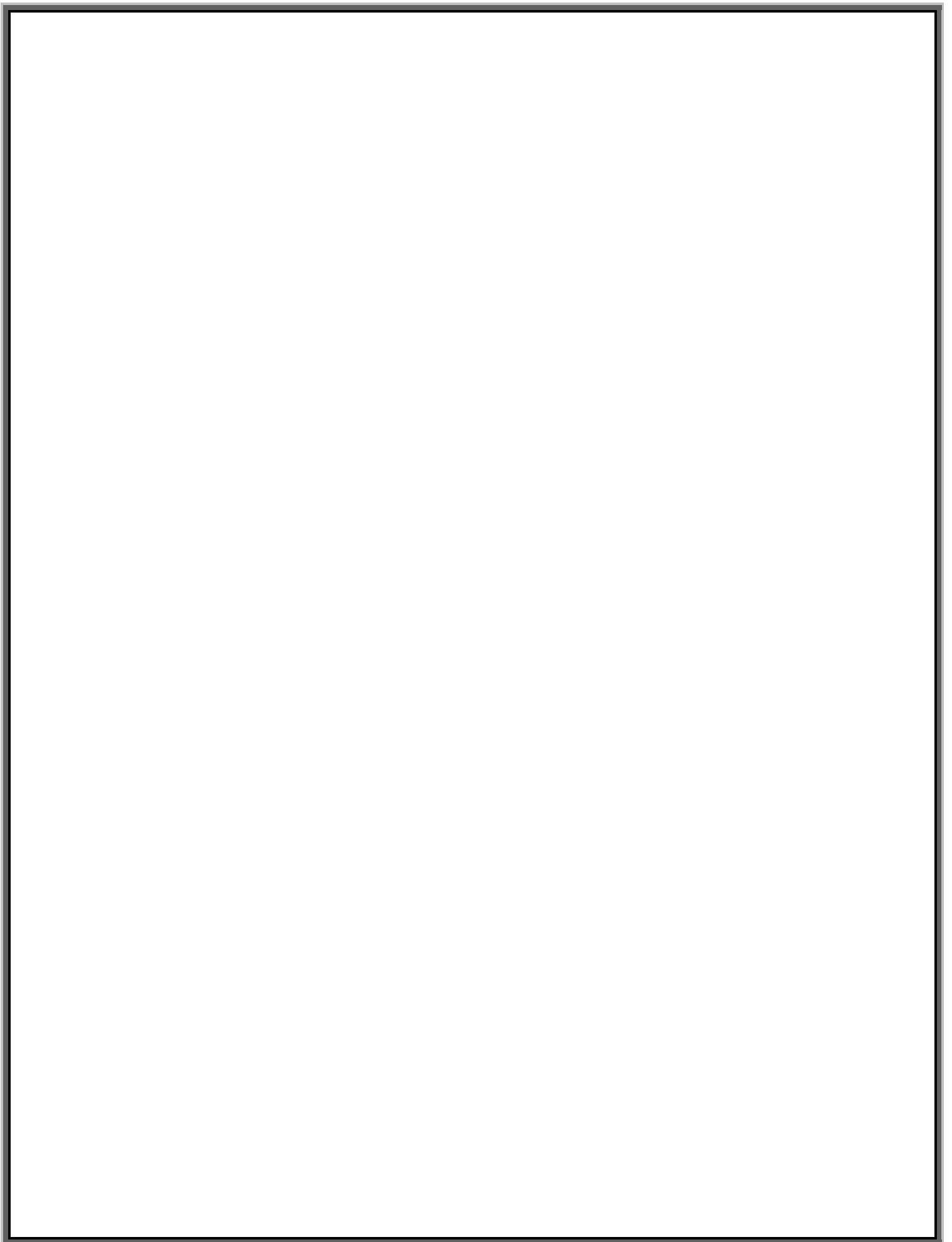
A reminder to 7/8 choir, Passagio, of the rehearsal today. We are getting ready for the Remembrance Day assembly so make sure you are there!

The library will be closed today and tomorrow - Thursday and Friday - due to immunizations by the Health Unit.

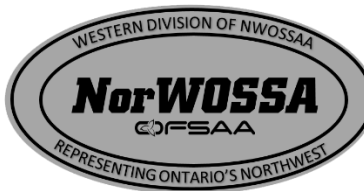
